 - Sr. Boys & Girls – 4:30-6:00 p.m.

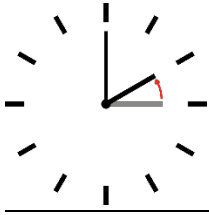
Thursday – Day 5
